## **INSTRUCTIONS**


- 1. Print the instructions, one "To: Tooth Fairy" and one "From: Tooth Fairy" envelope; print double-sided.
- 2. Cut out the envelopes and envelope seals along the dashed lines.
- 3. Fill out the forms on the insides of the envelopes before assembling; the "To: Tooth Fairy" form will be filled by the lucky kid who lost a tooth. The "From: Tooth Fairy" form will be filled out by the Tooth Fairy herself.
- 4. Assemble the envelope by folding the side flaps inward along the solid line, then fold and glue the bottom flap over the side flaps.
- 5. Once envelopes have been filled, either with a tooth-filled pouch or the Tooth Fairy's gift, apply glue to the back of the envelope seal and use to glue the envelope closed.




